EYPP – Communication and Language

Case Study — Maisie age 3, attends Little Ladybirds Pre-School for the full 15 hours over 5 days and is entitled to £7.95 EYPP per week. After checking Maisie's Progress Tracker and Child Monitoring Tool, her key person identifies that she is at risk of delay in the area of Communication and Language, particularly listening and attention.

The pre-school decides to spend £5.03 to increase 1 to 1 support for 3 x 15 minute sessions per week for Maisie to work on her listening and attention next steps. Every two weeks, Maisie's key person will also spend 30 minutes with parents to discuss home learning and prepare resources to be shared at home - £1.68 per week. Maisie's key person has recognised Maisie's communication and language progress when working with puppets in the setting. The setting will set some money aside to buy additional puppets this term.

Case Study – Charlotte age 3, attends a childminder for 12 hours a week and is entitled to £6.36 per week EYPP. Charlotte's childminder has identified that she will need some support with her understanding and expressive language.

Charlotte's childminder has decided to purchase an ICAN training resource which she thinks will enhance her capacity to support Charlotte's spoken language and understanding - £60. She has budgeted for EYPP for the whole term and allowed herself 3 extra hours to look through the ICAN materials in order to implement these strategies for Charlotte.

Training resource (cost spread over term) £60.00

Training hours (cost spread over term) £20.10

Average weekly spend £6.16

Case Study – Zafar age 4, attends a day nursery for 15 hours a week and is entitled to £7.95 EYPP. Zafar's day nursery has created an action plan to work towards improving Zafar's social communication. Sam and Joseph attend the day nursery too, are also entitled to EYPP and would benefit from small group communication and language work.

The day nursery has decided to combine the EYPP money for Zafar, Sam and Joseph (£23.85 per week) to provide small group activities each day - £8.38 per week. The nursery will also provide extra time for the key person for each child to plan and assess each child's progress - £10.05 per week. Joseph also receives input from a Speech and Language Therapist. The day nursery will fund Joseph's key person to be allowed extra time to liaise with the Speech and Language Therapist to discuss his progress and intervention strategies - £1.03 per week.

The setting will retain some EYPP money per week to fund resources for the small group activities.
