

## Early Years Initial Teacher Training Routes (EYITT)

### Routes

Graduate Entry	12 months FULL TIME
<b>Graduate Employment Based</b>	<b>12 months PART TIME whilst in employment</b>
Undergraduate Entry	3 Years Full Time including Early Childhood Studies Degree
Assessment Only	Graduate with experience across 0-5 and KS1 3 months PART TIME

**Routes typically commence in September, training providers will be interviewing potential candidates over the Spring and Summer months, enrol early.**

### Graduate Employment Based Entry Requirements

GCSE English, Maths and a Science at Grade 4 or above/Grade C or above or a certificate from <http://www.equivalencytesting.com/> (Not Key or Functional Skills)

Hold a Degree and have relevant experience

Length of route typically 12 months

### Graduate Employment Based Further Information

This route is fully funded and a bursary of up to £7,000 is available from the universities to the setting.

**12 months route will involve approximately 15 face to face sessions**
