# Stakeholder information

Action: academies to make monitoring and moderation agreements with local authorities by 22 November

Academies must make a written agreement with their chosen local authority (LA) for:

- monitoring the 2020 phonics screening check and key stage 2 (KS2) tests
- external moderation of their key stage 1 (KS1) and KS2 teacher assessment

If this is not your geographical LA, you must report this information in the <u>Primary Assessment Gateway</u> by Friday 22 November.

### Publication: 2020 teacher assessment guidance

We have published the statutory 2020 teacher assessment guidance for KS1 and KS2.

Both guidance documents contain 'changes' sections. These outline important differences for 2019/20.

Please note, the teacher assessment frameworks remain unchanged for this academic year. You should use the <u>KS1</u> and <u>KS2</u> teacher assessment frameworks for 2018/19 onwards.
